Protecting Your Prayers

- * God wants us to go to Him in prayer, but He also gives us His terms for answering our prayers. He will only answer prayers that inline with his will.
- * The enemy wants to attack your prayer life, if he can keep you from praying effectively, he steals your power, your peace, your strength, and your hope. He deceives us into sin, doubt, and unforgivness to hinder our prayers
- * When our prayers are hindered, we have no power.

Verse of the Week:

Psalm 66:18

If I had known of any sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened to me.

Sin separates us from God and hinders our prayers (it blocks the conversation).

Hinders – To cut off, to delay, to create difficulties for.

- To keep our prayers safe, we must live a blameless, <u>righteous</u> lifestyle.

Righteous – Very good, excellent, morally right.

- We must address ANY sin in our life with repentance.

Proverbs 15:29 (NIV) - The Lord is far from the wicked, but he hears the prayer of the righteous.

Unforgivness steals your blessings and your peace.

- When we pray, we must <u>forgive</u> others so that we may be forgiven.

Forgive–Stop feeling angry or resentful toward (someone) for an offense, flaw, or mistake.

Mark 11:25 (NIV) - And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."

We must pray in faith and God will give us the desires of our hearts.

- God cannot answer a prayer unless you believe that he will
- Doubt hinders our prayers.

Doubt- To not believe, to question

James 1:6-7 (NIV)- But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. 7 That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord.
