I TRUST IN CHRIST ALONE!

Base Verse: Acts 19:4 NLT

Paul's message about Jesus was simple, and he made sure people understood the full truth about salvation and who Jesus was. In Acts 19, Paul visited Ephesus and found believers who knew about John the Baptist's call for repentance but hadn't heard about Jesus. They had shown a desire to change their lives, but they needed to understand that Jesus had already come and was the only way to be saved. Paul explained that baptism should now be done in Jesus' name, emphasizing that baptism is not just about cleansing with water but represents starting a new life through faith in Jesus.



SALVATION VS BAPTISM

Salvation is like a gift that God gives us. It's when we believe in Jesus and ask Him to forgive our sins. Jesus saves us because He loves us, and we can't earn it by doing good things. It's a gift that happens in our hearts when we trust in Jesus to save us from our sin.



Baptism is like a celebration or a public announcement. It doesn't save us from sin, but it shows everyone in our lives what has already happened inside our hearts. When we get baptized, we are telling the world, "I believe in Jesus, and I'm starting a new life with Him!"
