WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE BORN AGAIN?

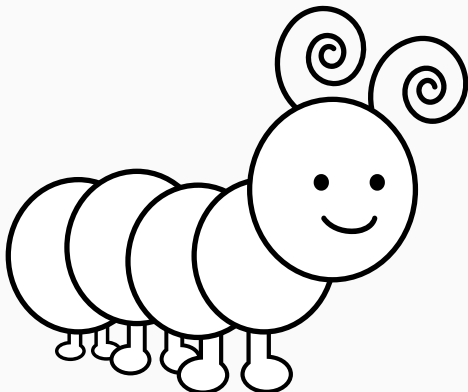

WHAT JESUS MEANT...

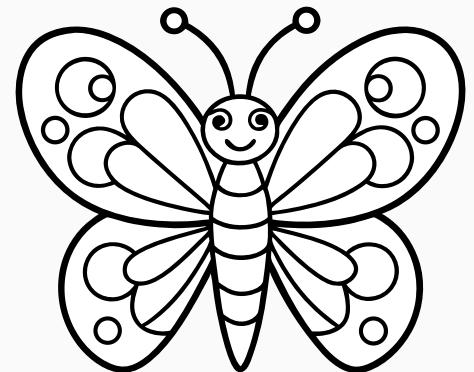
When you were born, your body came into the world. But Jesus says we need to be born again—not in our bodies, but in our hearts.
