

**“EVERYONE WHO SEES THE SON AND BELIEVES IN HIM HAS ETERNAL LIFE. I WILL RAISE HIM UP ON THE LAST DAY. THIS IS WHAT MY FATHER WANTS.”**

*“...shall have eternal life...”*

Jesus gives forever life—life with God that starts now and never ends. Eternal life isn't just about heaven someday, it's a new kind of life we live with God today.

♥ *Why This Matters:*

John 6:40 shows us the heart of God—He wants everyone to be saved. It also shows us the heart of Jesus—He came to bring us eternal life and promises to raise us up to be with Him forever.

This verse gives us hope, security, and joy. When we believe in Jesus, we don't have to fear being forgotten, rejected, or lost. We are part of God's forever family.

*“...and I will raise them up at the last day.”*

Even after we die, Jesus promises to bring us back to life with new, perfect bodies to live with Him forever. This is a powerful promise of resurrection—that death is not the end for those who believe in Him.
